Meticulous record keeping, documentation of donor intent per donation or gift

Apollo's Troupe, LLC seeks a fundraiser to support the performance of Frederick Glaysher's The Parliament of Poets. As is well known, theatre has three methods of fundraising: investment, the non-profit "broken" model, and donations and gifts. The first two result in a board of directors and the diminishment of creative independence and control for the artist. IRS rules for an LLC are different from nonprofits. There is nothing unethical or illegal in making money in theatre and the arts. Apollo's Troupe, LLC seeks to revive the old model of true **Patronage**, direct donations and gifts, preserving its artistic integrity.

Find potential supporters to Ask for a Patron Donation or Gift (Not Tax Deductible). Help Bring the Message of Peace and Global Community to audiences for 4 to 12 weeks.

The Fundraiser will be paid a 10% commission on funds raised, as an independent contractor, which will maximize what one can earn. Versus fixed hours and wages or a salary, one would earn based on performance and production, independently determining one's own hours and approach and procedures to achieve the financial goals as outlined. How good are your existing fundraising connections? How much do you want to earn? How fast? 20 or 30 to 60 days? Scale with Apollo's Troupe, LLC. Once Patron funds are deposited in Apollo's Troupe, LLC bank account, via one of two methods outlined below, and the bank confirms they've cleared, the fundraiser will receive an accumulated deposit into their bank account by the end of that month. Non-exclusive contract, meaning more than one fundraiser may be hired. No subcontractors may be used. Verification of identity via SSN on W-9 and State Driver's License.
